Kenilworth Castle visit Tuesday 14th May 2019

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of your child's studies for their Key Stage 3 History course, we have arranged a fieldtrip to Kenilworth Castle in Warwickshire. During the day your child will undertake fieldwork that will enable them to develop their understanding of why castles were developed and how they changed over time.

During their visit the students will have the opportunity to take a guided tour of the castle site viewing the buildings and grounds. The site is an excellent example of Norman and Tudor life and will give the pupils an excellent insight into what life would have been like during that time period. The cost of the trip is £8.00, which includes coach travel and admission to the site. If your child is entitled to pupil premium funding there will be no charge for this activity.

The coaches will leave Dame Elizabeth Cadbury at **9.00am prompt** and will return at approximately **3pm**. Please arrange for your child to be picked up at this time so that they may arrive home safely. Pupils must bring sufficient food and drink for the day. **As the pupils will be working outdoors sensible clothing is essential, and a waterproof coat as the weather can quickly change. They will be required to walk on uneven terrain therefore the pupils will need to wear sensible shoes. Additionally should the weather improve they will need to bring plenty to drink, sun cream and a sun hat.**

Please complete and return the reply slip together with a payment of £8.00, cheques made payable to Dame Elizabeth Cadbury School. All reply slips should be placed in a sealed envelope and deposited in the School Post Box which is located in the foyer outside of the main School Hall by Friday 5th April 2019. In addition payment can also be made through the WisePay online payment system which can be accessed via the school website. If your child requires medication or suffers from any allergies or conditions requiring special treatment please complete the necessary medical information over the page. **Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Demand is likely to exceed places so a prompt return is recommended.**
