**Blists Hill Trip Tuesday 22nd October 2019**

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of your child's studies for their Key Stage 3 history course, we have arranged a fieldtrip to Blists Hill Village Victorian Museum in Shropshire.

During their visit the students will have the opportunity to take a guided tour of the Blists Hill site viewing the buildings and grounds. There will be activities taking place such as candle making which they will be able to view and learn from. The site is an excellent example of Victorian life and will give the pupils an excellent insight into what life would have been like during that time period. In the afternoon we will visit the Enginuity Museum which has an exhibition and hands on learning activities involving science. We will also view the world famous Ironbridge - the first bridge in the world to be built from iron. The cost of the trip is £16.00, which includes coach travel and admission to both sites. If your child is entitled to pupil premium funding there will be no charge for this activity.

The coaches will leave Dame Elizabeth Cadbury at **9.00am prompt** and will return at approximately **5pm**. Please arrange for your child to be picked up at this time so that they may arrive home safely. Pupils must bring sufficient food and drink for the day. **As the pupils will be working outdoors sensible clothing is essential, either jogging bottoms or leggings, and a waterproof coat as the weather can quickly change. They will be required to walk on uneven terrain therefore the pupils will need to wear sensible shoes. Additionally should the weather improve they will need to bring plenty to drink, sun cream and a sun hat.**

Please complete and return the reply slip together with a payment of £16.00, cheques made payable to Dame Elizabeth Cadbury School and If you wish for your child to take part in this trip, please read and complete the form overleaf, sign it and return it in a sealed envelope with your child's name and form on it by **Friday 4th October 2019**. The envelope must be placed in the letter box in the foyer. In addition, payment can also be made through the WisePay online payment system that can be accessed via the school website. We will be limited to 60 places and they will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
