Dear Parent/ Carer,

We wrote to you recently to outline the process and anticipated feedback from our recent Ofsted inspection.

We are pleased to share with you the final Ofsted report that confirms that we continue to be a good school.

The report will go live on Ofsted's website and our own website on Thursday 24th October.

We hope that you will recognise the many positive observations, conclusions and strengths that inspectors have commented on. We value the recommendations that have been made, most of which are in-line with the school improvement plan for this year. As well as the priorities identified by inspectors, we would like to provide some additional performance information to supplement our inspection report:

The specific areas for development have been discussed with governors, Academy Trustees and staff. We have already begun working on many of the areas identified, as we want the school to grow further to be the best it can possibly be.

As mentioned in my previous letter, we know that we can expect a full Section 5 inspection within the next one to two years, which will enable the school to be re-graded against the full Ofsted inspection framework.
