Dear Parents/ Carers,

We hope that you continue to remain safe and well.

As you will be aware, the centre assessed grading process for all Year 11 pupils was completed by teachers, faculty leaders and senior staff earlier this term. This information was submitted to exam boards who are now conducting their own moderation process to finalise actual results following the guidance given to them by OfQUAL.

We have previously stated our intention to meet pupils in person on results day if it is safe to do so. This is to ensure every pupil feels supported and has access to immediate guidance in the next stage of their education. We are pleased to announce that this will take place on **Thursday 20th August**.

To ensure that the day is conducted in line with government safety guidance, pupils must only arrive at school during their allocated time slot. On arrival, pupils will be directed to the white tunnel to complete hand washing prior to entry into the school building. Once complete, pupils will be escorted to the relevant school area for collection of their results:
