### Reopening from Monday 8th March – Letter 2

### Electric Scooters and Travel to School

A number of pupils have asked about using electric scooters to travel to and from school. As was the case in the Autumn Term, we encourage pupils to walk or cycle to school and avoid using public transport if possible. This guidance remains and is noted in The Government's most recent documentation to support the reopening of Schools.



Pupil safety and protection is our ultimate propriety. We have sought advice on the overall safety, legalities and insurance implications for electric scooters such as the one pictured. These scooters are not a legal mode of transport and further, they do not carry suitable insurance to cover pupils in the event of an accident. As such, pupils will not be allowed to travel to or from school using an electric scooter. If brought onto school site, we will have no choice but to confiscate until parents/ carers can come into school to collect.

### Home testing for all members of the household

On Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> February, it was announced that rapid lateral flow testing would be made available to all households of school pupils and staff. This means that in addition to the three initial tests and then twice-weekly home testing for DEC pupils, households are also now able to access home testing kits.
